

Talking Points to Members of Congress for support and action regarding the situation in Sudan

- 1) Request that a letter be sent (draft provided) to Secretary Clinton emphasizing the need for vigorous monitoring of the Comprehensive Peace Agreement (CPA) by the US and global partners, holding parties accountable for complying with the CPA.
- 2) Increase funding to support election monitoring and civic education around forthcoming elections and request that Secretary Clinton provide estimates to the Appropriations Committees for funding the needs to respond to the enormity of the challenge.
- 3) Request that Special Envoy Gration meet with Archbishop Daniel Deng Bul and other Church leaders for enlisting Sudanese Churches in ensuring an informed electorate and fair elections in 2010 and 2011.
- 4) Request that the Member of Congress support the re-institution of the Sudan Caucus in Congress to develop a unified voice on behalf of US concerns and interest in maintaining the CPA which we as a country were primarily responsible for in enacting.
